

Caving and potholing is about going underground to scramble, climb, traverse, and explore water streams, meanders, narrow passages, massive chambers, and hidden corners full of amazing formations. It requires no prior experience or equipment as there are caves for all levels, from simple walking to shafts requiring complex ropework, and you can borrow everything from the club.

For over 60 years, the caving club has been introducing many to the exciting underworld!

The training sessions are free. Trying it out only costs £25 and £32 for short and long weekend meets respectively. This includes transport, accommodation, caving gear, and food. Your insurance is paid by the club during the first two weeks.

CUCC organises caving meets every other weekend during Full Term, so there are plenty of opportunities for you (see calendar overleaf). There are longer trips in the Easter and Summer vacations. The club is not just about caving: while in Cambridge there are plenty of activities and socials that are spontaneously announced on the email list, including pub meets, training sessions in vertical techniques (SRT), dinners, cycling and climbing trips, etc.
